The Autobiography of Lui Che-woo (呂志和傳), which is based on his oral description of his life stories, was unveiled this evening. It not only presents Dr Lui's life and successes, but also reveals how this commercial giant called on his wisdom and compassion to overcome turbulence and frustration to achieve massive success. The book also portrays Dr Lui as one who upholds the philosophy of "sharing in harmony; enjoying the blessing of being ordinary". The autobiography has also revealed the history and many anecdotes of the Lui's family for the first time.

Actively Giving Back to Society to Celebrate its 60th Anniversary

Established in Hong Kong for 60 years, K. Wah Group has upheld the belief of "Giving back to society from which one has benefitted".
